About the Program

The Student Leaders Solidarity Camp is a 4-day, 3-night experiential learning camp designed to:

- Develop leadership qualities and resilience
- Expose participants to the culture and way of life of the KDMR community
- Build solidarity among student leaders from various institutions
- Promote social responsibility and community awareness



Objective

1. To serve as a platform for leadership participation among student leaders from Malaysian Higher Education Institutions with the KDMR community in the interior of Sabah.
2. To cultivate cooperation, tolerance, and goodwill between participants and the KDMR community
3. To provide exposure to the traditions, culture, and lifestyle of the KDMR community.

Camp Details

Venue: Koisaan Cultural Village (KCV),

KDCA, Penampang, Sabah

Date: 16 – 19 December 2025

Duration: 4 Days & 3 Nights

Participants: 150 – 200 student leaders



What to Expect

Participants will engage in:

- Community service activities with the Kadazan Dusun Murut Rungus (KDMR) community.
- Leadership workshops and group discussions
- Cultural exposure such as traditional food, dance, and KDMR especially Murut traditions
- Team-building and outdoor activities
- Reflection sessions and group bonding

Code of Conduct

All participants are expected to:

- Demonstrate respect for local culture, customs, and KCV rules
- Maintain discipline and punctuality at all times
- Wear appropriate and modest attire
- Participate fully in all scheduled activities
- Avoid any behaviour that may endanger self or others
- Uphold the reputation of their institution and the organisers
- Adhere to safety instructions by camp facilitators



Prohibition

- Alcohol, drugs, and smoking or vaping
- Vandalism or disrespecting cultural artefacts
- Leaving the campsite without permission
- Any form of harassment or inappropriate conduct

Safety Guidelines

- Stay with your assigned group during activities
- Inform facilitators of your medical complication
- Wear appropriate shoes suitable for outdoor activities
- Keep your hydration level high
- Be mindful of longhouse structural rules (e.g., raised flooring, wooden beams)
- Follow instructions during cultural demonstrations
- Emergency evacuation procedures will be briefed on Day 1

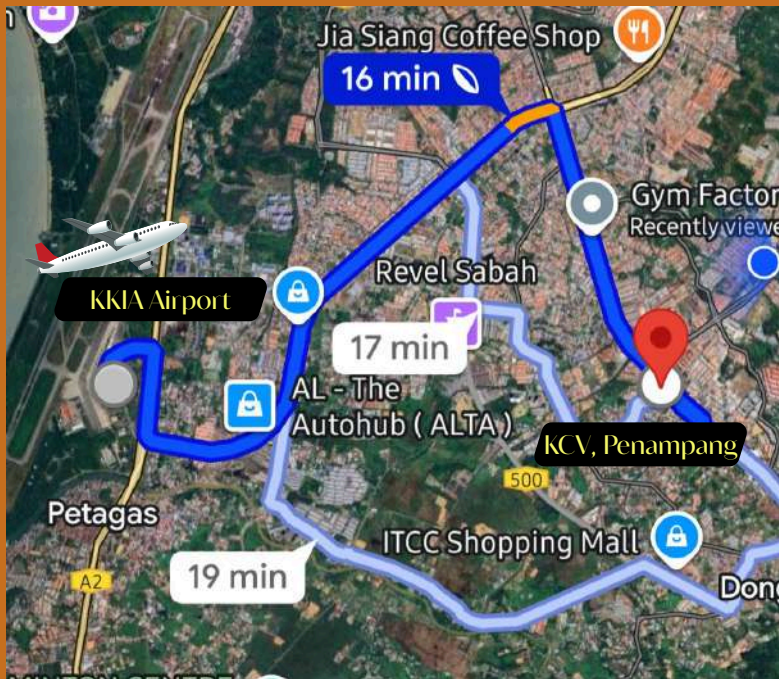
Packing Checklist

1)Mandatory Items

- Appropriate shoes and a pair slipper
- Toiletries
- Towel

- Extra cash for personal use
- Notebook & pen
- Personal medication (If any)
- Power bank
- Insect repellent
- Encourage to bring your traditional costume



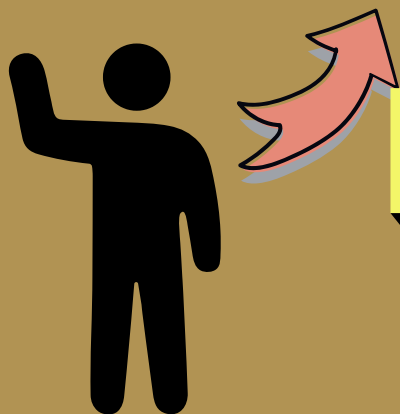
Transportation
